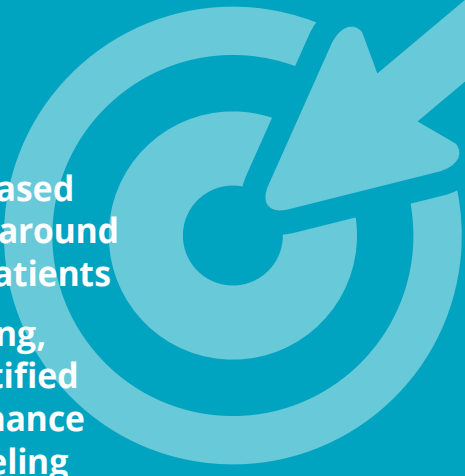

YEAR 1

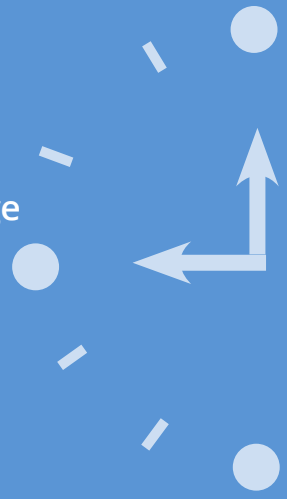
Onboarding partners to three separate projects—GDM, CDS, eCQM

WHAT THEY DID



AllianceChicago developed a patient registry (identified patients in need of care) and a highly intentional care coordination for the high-risk patients in the registry.



OCHIN developed an Express Lane to gather information from different locations within the EHR that would be relevant to the postpartum period, especially GDM, contraception, and depression.
