# The Value of NACHC Membership

## Advocacy

For 50+ years, NACHC has been the lead advocate for the community health center movement – funded by NACHC membership.

NACHC's advocacy generated critical funding to address the COVID-19 pandemic, including \$7.6 billion specifically for health centers, with \$1 billion appropriated for health center construction and renovation projects. In December 2022, community health centers received annual appropriation increases, including a \$110 million increase in FY23.



## Training and Technical Assistance

NACHC provides training and education to health centers, primary care association staff, and health center boards on a variety of programmatic, legal, regulatory, and clinical issues. Between 2020 and 2022, NACHC delivered 275 training events, and reached 40,000 health center learners.

## Conferences and Events

NACHC members save more than \$1,000 on registration to our signature conferences.

These inspiring events allow you to network with experts and leaders while gaining new insights to advance your health center and career.



## Grant Funding

NACHC members are eligible to apply for pass through grant opportunities valued between \$5,000 and \$100,000.

Between 2020 and 2022, NACHC raised nearly \$24 million from private and corporate foundations supporting health centers, primary care associations, and health center controlled networks.
