


1 IN 5 RURAL RESIDENTS RELY ON CHCS

Community Health Centers Serving Rural America

Community Health Centers (CHCs) serve as the primary care home for nearly 10 million rural patients (1 in 5 rural residents) at 6.5K locations across the country (41% of all CHCs serve rural communities).



CHCs are a critical source of comprehensive, high quality, cost-effective, integrated primary care for rural populations. Rural communities face significant health access challenges, such as provider shortages, greater travel distances to care, and higher rates of chronic disease.¹ Rural CHCs serve mountain, island, tribal, and frontier communities and are also major economic engines, generating at least 130K rural health center jobs and sustaining local economies through \$13.3 billion in spending. Rural CHCs deliver high quality primary care to patients and reduce overall US healthcare costs. Rural CHCs also:

- Offer virtual care with more than 3.3 million telehealth visits.
- Provide care to 215K veterans, 235K patients experiencing homelessness, and 2.6 million children and 1.6 million elderly patients.




Over 1 million individuals with diabetes had over

 68% of individuals aged 18 to 74 with diabetes, served at rural health centers, have controlled blood sugar levels.

Hypertension

 Over 2 million individuals with hypertension had over 5.3 million visits at rural CHCs



 73% of individuals aged 18 to 84 with hypertension, served at rural CHCs, have controlled blood pressure.
