

438 Health Center Delivery Sites

The 27 federally-funded health center organizations in Washington leverage \$136,523,623 in federal investments to serve 1,224,996 patients, 14% of whom are uninsured and 57% of whom are covered by Medicaid.



Notes | Delivery sites represent locations of organizations funded by the federal Health Center Program. Health Center Program Look-Alikes are community-based health care providers that meet the requirements of the HRSA Health Center Program, but do not receive Health Center Program funding. Some locations may overlap due to scale or may otherwise not be visible when mapped. Federal investments represent the total funding from the federal Health Center Program to grantees with a presence in the state in 2023.
