

Medicaid Dental Providers Tobacco Cessation Training

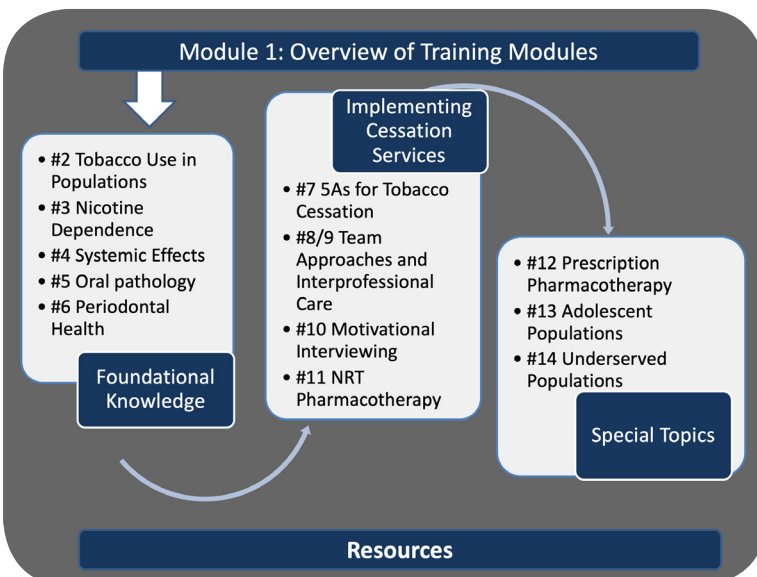


As of January 1, 2018, the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) began reimbursing participating dentists for providing tobacco cessation services to their patients who receive Medicaid services. Dental professionals can help smokers quit by consistently identifying patients who smoke, advising them to quit, and offering them information about cessation treatment.
