National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC) and
Americares Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) Initiative



NACHC and AmeriCares are awarding [MHFA Instructor Adult Training Scholarships](#) to ten (10) CHCs (Community Health Centers) or Primary Care Associations (PCAs) to sponsor one (1) staff member each to become a certified MHFA instructor through the National Council for Mental Wellbeing.

The 8-hour training teaches individuals how to:

- identify risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns
- strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations
- where to turn for assistance

MHFA Instructor Adult Training consists of an in-person or virtual training. Certified MHFA instructors are required to deliver a minimum of three (3) MHFA 8-hour course trainings over the course of a year to maintain instructor certification.

The AmeriCares scholarship will provide each selected organization with a \$5,000 grant.
