

Program Funding Opportunity:

National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC) and Americares Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) Initiative





NACHC and Americares are awarding MHFA Instructor Adult Training Scholarships to ten (10) CHCs (Community Health Centers) or Primary Care Associations (PCAs) to sponsor one (1) staff member each to become a certified MHFA instructor through the National Council for Mental Wellbeing.

The 8-hour training teaches individuals how to:

- identify risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns
- strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations
- where to turn for assistance

MHFA Instructor Adult Training consists of an inperson or virtual training. Certified MHFA instructors are required to deliver a minimum of three (3) MHFA 8-hour course trainings over the course of a year to maintain instructor certification.

The Americares scholarship will provide each selected organization with a \$5,000 grant.
