


5 A's Workflow & Documentation

- Patient health history includes questions on tobacco, vape and e-cigarette use
- During every exam (D0120, D0140 & D0150) all adult patients are queried on tobacco use history.
- Smoking status is documented in the medical alerts and clinical notes

SNOMED Concept ID	SNOMED Description	Detailed Description
266919005	Never smoked tobacco	Never smoker: an individual who has not smoked 100 or more cigarettes during his/her lifetime
266927001	Tobacco smoking consumption unknown	Unknown if ever smoked: unknown if an individual has ever smoked
428041000124106	Occasional tobacco smoker	Current some day smoker: an individual who has smoked at least 100 cigarettes during his/her lifetime and still regularly smokes periodically, yet consistently
428061000124105	Light tobacco smoker	Light tobacco smoker: an individual who smokes less than 10 cigarettes per day, or an equivalent (but less concretely defined) quantity of cigar or pipe smoke
428071000124103	Heavy tobacco smoker	Heavy tobacco smoker: an individual who smokes more than 10 cigarettes per day, or an equivalent (but less concretely defined) quantity of cigar or pipe smoke
449868002	Smokes tobacco daily	Current every day smoker: an individual who has smoked at least 100 cigarettes during his/her lifetime and still regularly smokes every day
77176002	Smoker	Smoker, current status unknown: an individual who has smoked at least 100 cigarettes during his/her lifetime, but whether they currently still smoke is unknown
8517006	Ex-smoker	Former smoker: an individual who has smoked at least 100 cigarettes during his/her lifetime but does not currently smoke
