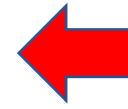
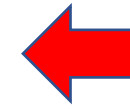
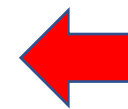

- Start Budesonide Aerosol Powder Breath Activated, 90 MCG/ACT, 1 puff, Inhalation, Once a day, 30 day(s), 1 inhaler, Refills 3
- Start Albuterol Sulfate HFA Aerosol Solution, 108 (90 Base) MCG/ACT, 2 puff as needed for cough/wheezing, Inhalation, every 4 hrs, 30 days, 1 Box, Refills 3
- Start Spacer/Aero-Holding Chambers Device, -, use with inhaler, inhalation, every 4 hours as needed, 30 days, 1 each, Refills 1

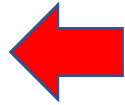

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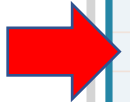
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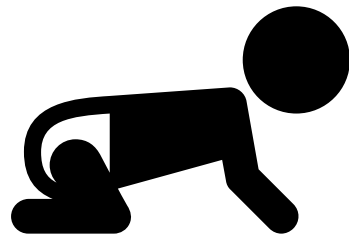
