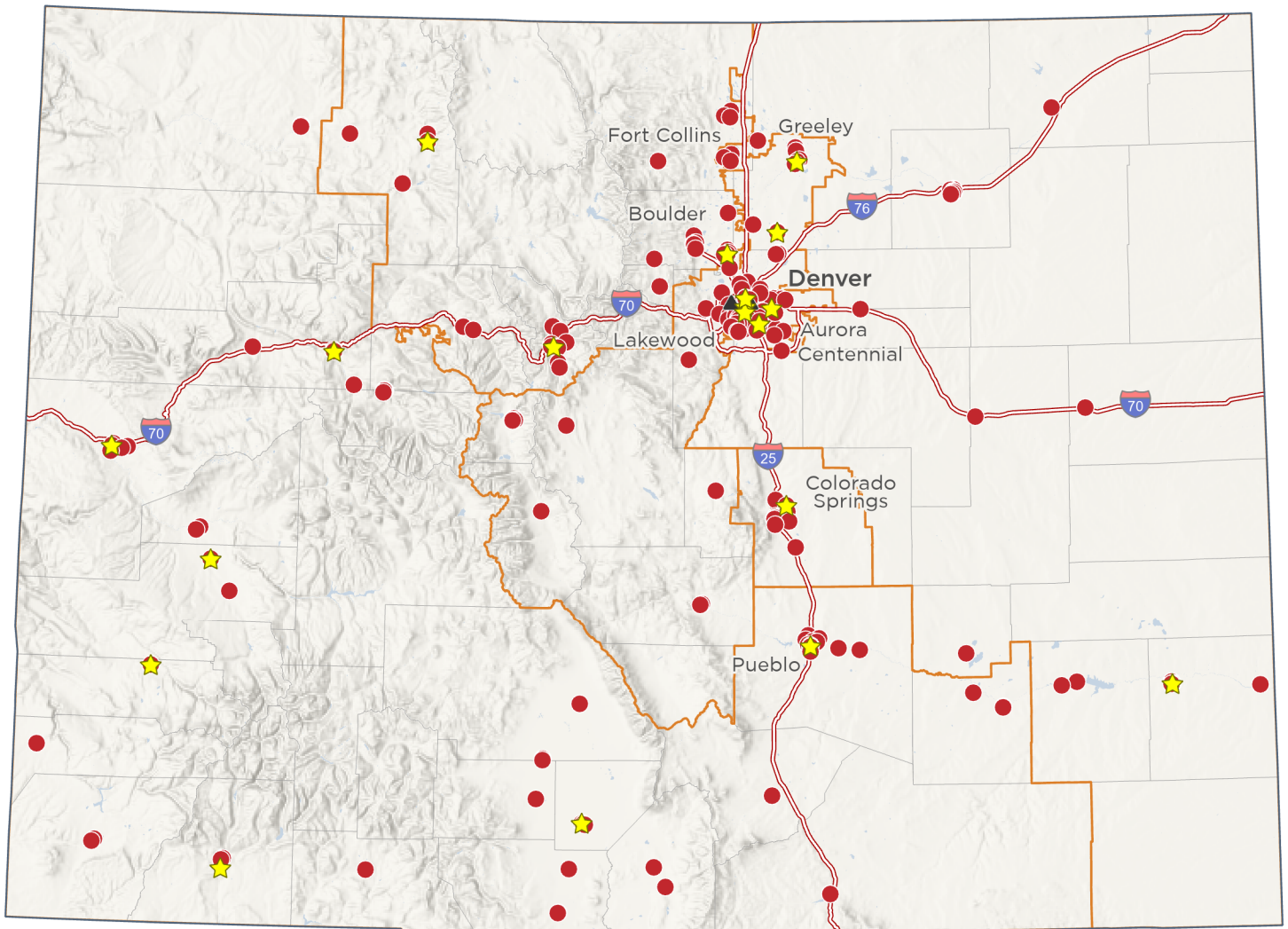




The 19 federally-funded health center organizations in Colorado leverage **\$110,662,993** in federal investments to serve **634,878** patients, 27% of whom are uninsured and 44% of whom are covered by Medicaid.

Federal investments represent the total funding from the federal Health Center Program to grantees with a presence in the state in 2021.
