Introduction: The NACHC Quality Center is excited to offer Community Health Worker Professional Skills 101 as a course offering in the fall 2023 Health Center

Professional Development Program. The Quality Center recognizes the critical importance of providing access to training opportunities for health center professionals to build skills, develop competencies, and advance careers while driving improved patient care and health outcomes. More specifically, these trainings help to achieve the Quintuple Aim: improved health outcomes, improved patient experiences, improved staff experiences, reduced costs, and equity.

Course Description: This course provides foundational skills for health center staff to carry out the responsibilities of a Community Health Worker.

Who Should Apply: Community Health Workers/CHWs (or professionals in similar roles, such as patient navigators) whose focus is on improving individual patient and community health and health access. While this can encompass staff in a wide variety of job roles and titles, the focus is on building connections where people live, learn, work, worship, and heal, from the inner city to rural communities.

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Training includes:

- 12-month access to tools, templates, and Solution Center resources (a platform of like-minded individuals to promote healthcare transformation through learning)
- 20 asynchronous courses (approximately 30 hours) participants complete on their own
- Four 90-minute live sessions with discussion and customized coaching support from faculty and experts
- Quizzes and assignments
- Completion of all online modules, participation in the live sessions, and live-session assignments are required to receive a Certificate of Completion and Continuing Education Credits.

Attendants complete the 20 asynchronous courses (approximately 30 hours) on their own, supported by four 90-minute guided courses.
