TOOLKIT OVERVIEW AND PURPOSE

Improving patients' hypertension control and optimizing their cholesterol management often takes ongoing conversations and education. It also requires continuous effort from all care team members to stay current on the latest evidence-based care and treatment strategies and effectively communicate them with patients.

NACHC has created the Hypertension and Cholesterol Management Communication Toolkit to assist health center leaders, communicators, quality improvement specialists, and clinical care coordinators in Health Care Center Networks (HCCNs) and Primary Care Associations (PCAs). The purpose of this toolkit is to help share evidence-based messages about controlling hypertension and managing cholesterol with care teams and patients.

The toolkit includes content for internal care team emails, e-newsletters, and social media posts intended for health professional colleagues or health center patients. These templates are designed to encourage collaboration, offer best practices, and provide resources to help clinicians and care teams effectively assist patients diagnosed with hypertension and high cholesterol in managing their chronic diseases.

We hope you'll use or adapt these templates to facilitate conversations among clinicians and care teams to enhance patients' control of hypertension, optimize cholesterol management, and address patient concerns.

Sample Email about Optimizing Cholesterol Management

SUBJECT: Resources to Optimize Cholesterol Management and Address Patient Concerns about Statin Therapy

Dear [HEALTH CENTER CLINICIAN AND CARE TEAM STAFF],

As a team, we are always working to enhance our approach to helping our patients who are at risk for atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease, or ASCVD, to optimize their cholesterol management. I would like to share some valuable resources that can help us improve our cholesterol management protocols and have meaningful discussions with patients about reducing their risks of heart disease and stroke, especially addressing their concerns about statin therapy.

While we understand that lifestyle changes such as diet and exercise are important for maintaining cardiovascular health, we also recognize the significant benefits of prescribing statins for patients struggling with cholesterol management or at elevated risk of a cardiovascular event. However, many patients have questions and concerns about statins, and some are hesitant or influenced by misinformation that can impact their overall cardiovascular risk management.

When discussing statins with patients, it is essential to anticipate questions and provide reliable educational resources. Some patients require multiple discussions to decide to begin statin therapy and support to sustain it. We have learned that ongoing engagement is key to enhancing adherence and improving outcomes.

SUBJECT: Resources and Strategies for Hypertension Control

Dear [HEALTH CENTER CLINICIAN AND CARE TEAM STAFF],

Improving patients' hypertension control often requires continuous conversations, education, and effort from all care team members. This includes staying up-to-date on the latest evidence-based care and treatment strategies and effectively communicating them with patients.

I encourage all of us to closely examine our clinical approach for patients with hypertension and at risk for heart diseases and strokes who need treatment. Specifically, we should consider the benefits of intensifying treatment using combination therapy to achieve better control of hypertension.

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle is crucial for cardiovascular health. However, <u>research</u> indicates that intensifying treatment with two classes of anti-hypertensive medications, preferably in a fixed-dose combination (one pill), can significantly improve outcomes for patients who are having difficulty achieving adequate blood pressure control. In fact, most individuals require both approaches to reach their blood pressure goals. This is when treatment intensification should be considered.

Three of the most impactful medication treatment strategies to improve blood pressure control are:

- 1. Rapid treatment intensification
- 2. Increasing the frequency of follow-up
- 3. Improving medication adherence

This month, I encourage all of us to focus on medication intensification to enhance our efforts in managing hypertension. I've found some easy-to-understand resources that may be helpful when counseling our patients with hypertension. Let me know which ones you and our patients find helpful.
