

## 2,430 Health Center Delivery Sites

The 170 federally-funded health center organizations in California leverage \$693,486,865 in federal investments to serve 5,433,177 patients, 13% of whom are uninsured and 69% of whom are covered by Medicaid.



Notes | Delivery sites represent locations of organizations funded by the federal Health Center Program. Health Center Program Look-Alikes are community-based health care providers that meet the requirements of the HRSA Health Center Program, but do not receive Health Center Program funding. Some locations may overlap due to scale or may otherwise not be visible when mapped. Domestic violence shelters are mapped at the Health Center administrative site and do not represent service delivery site locations. Federal investments represent the total funding from the federal Health Center Program to grantees with a presence in the state in 2023.
