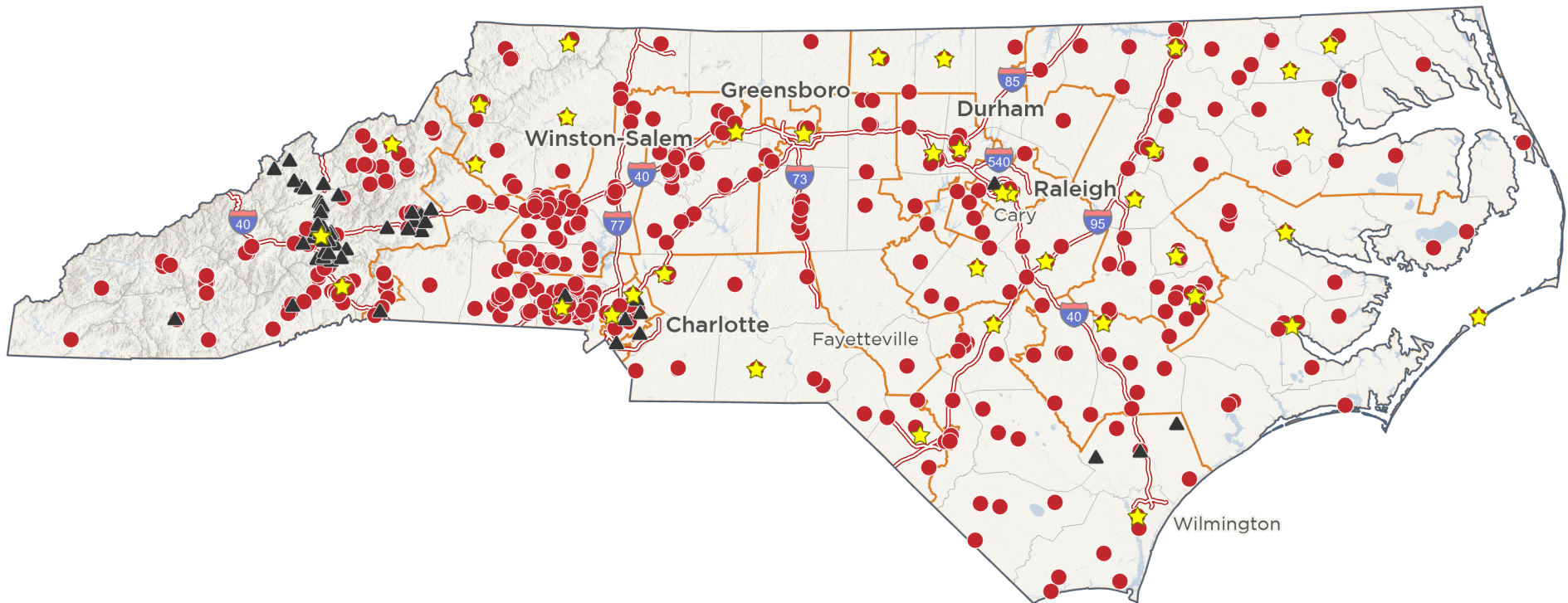


The 38 federally-funded health center organizations in North Carolina leverage **\$143,425,651** in federal investments to serve **694,057** patients, 33% of whom are uninsured and 26% of whom are covered by Medicaid.

Health Center Program Look-Alikes are community-based health care providers that meet the requirements of the HRSA Health Center Program, but do not receive Health Center Program funding. Some locations may overlap due to scale or may otherwise not be visible when mapped. Federal investments represent the total funding from the federal Health Center Program to grantees with a presence in the state in 2023.
